

CLASSROOM STANDARDS



These standards are in place to ensure that everyone has the best chance to learn in an outstanding learning environment and to ensure that you get the most out of your school day.

- place all equipment, books and your planner on the desk in front of you.
- place your coat on the back of your chair and bag safely under the table.
- write your **TITLE** or **DRIVING QUESTION** in your book along with the **DATE** this must be **UNDERLINED** with a **RULER**.
- you should only write in **BLACK** or **BLUE** pen.
- draw or complete any graphs or diagrams in **PENCIL** and use a **RULER** as required.
- ensure you are contributing to a positive learning environment.
- make sure that your work is always **NEAT** and **WELL PRESENTED**.
- respect the classroom, equipment and resources in the classroom.
- ensure that your behaviour is appropriate and exemplary at **ALL TIMES**.
- Be respectful, polite and well-mannered at **ALL TIMES**.
- always **RECORD YOUR HOMEWORK** in your planner and **SHOW YOUR TEACHER** before you leave the classroom.
- pack your equipment away at the end of each lesson and **STAND BEHIND YOUR CHAIR, IN SILENCE** and **WAIT** to be dismissed.
- leave the classroom in a **CALM** and **SENSIBLE MANNER**.

By following these standards you will be rewarded with passport and house points. Failure to comply with these standards will result in consequences and sanctions.
