



## A Level Results Wrotham School – August 2017

### Press Release:

For the 2<sup>nd</sup> year running we are celebrating consistently strong results at Wrotham School for our year 13 students. Our students have risen to the challenge of the new, reformed A Level qualifications and have performed at the highest level. As a school we are confident that our sixth form is providing an outstanding quality of teaching that is deeply embedded into a culture of success. We are on a journey that will continue to deliver top results through the introduction of the International Baccalaureate in September 2017 that will offer more choice, opportunity and challenge to our growing 6<sup>th</sup> form cohort.

This year **87%** achieved A-C grades in Year 13 with **63%** of those grades scoring at A-B, **99%** of students achieved a pass grade in their chosen qualification.

In subject departments, 100% of our Art students achieved an A\*- A grade at A level; 100% of Science, Business Studies, ICT and Sport students achieved a Distinction/ Distinction\* Grade at BTEC Level 3. In Sociology 88% of students achieved A-C grades at A Level; Science A Level, 100% of students achieved an A-C grade; 83% of A Level Photography students achieved an A-C grade; 80% of Geography students achieved A- C grades.
