GCSE Results Summer 2017

At Wrotham School we are delighted to be celebrating another year of record GCSE results with our students. Even following the introduction of the new tougher GCSE's we have seen our results improve again. We would like to congratulate all of our students who have successfully risen to the challenge. We are always proud of our students and staff achievements; these results are even more impressive when placed in a context that reflects a far greater number of students sitting traditional full GCSE courses and the increased rigour that they demand.

85 % of candidates achieved a pass grade or higher in English and 77% in mathematics. 72% of our students achieved a pass grade or higher in both English and mathematics

71% of students achieved a C or above in Triple Science, 81% gained C and above in History with 33% A/A* grades; in the new Computer Science GCSE 75% achieved C or above with 31% attaining A/A* grades; ICT achieved a 100% pass rate with 50% of those achieving the top grade in this qualification. Food Technology GCSE students achieved a 95% C and above pass rate and 100% of students sitting French GCSE achieved a C or above.

Notable individual achievements include Ivor Holmes achieving 5 X A and 3 X A* grades; Oliver Cox who achieved 2 X A Grades and 4 x A*grades 1 year early at the age of 15; Chloe Panayi achieved 3 X A and 2 X A* grades; James Hussey achieved 4 X A grades; Anya Renwick- Forster achieved 5 X A and 2 X A* grades; Bella Shave achieved 3 X A and 1 X A* grade; Abdul Kadir Uddin achieved 4 x A and 2 x A* grades; Harry Wade achieved 4 x A grades and finally Nisha Wiseman who achieved 6 X A and 2 A* grades as well as an 'A' level grade A in Maths 2 years early.
