# DID YOU KNOW?

- Volcán de Fuego is Spanish for Volcano of Fire



# WHY DID IT ERUPT

The Fuego volcano eruption was magma which causes a deadly avalanche of hot rocks, gas, and volcanic ash that races down the mountainside in a rapid pyroclastic flow.



## Key facts

The eruption included pyroclastic flows, and clouds of volcanic ash



The eruption was in Guatemala on Sunday 3 June



How many deaths!

It caused the death of nearly two hundred people. It was the deadliest eruption in Guatemala since 1929.



# ANIMALS?

Animals such as dogs, cats, chickens, monkeys, donkeys and other species were found by rescuers with burns or blinded by the eruption



# WAS THE ERUPTION FAMOUS

- Yes it was, because it was being constantly active at a low level.



# Does it effect the people ?

YES it does because.....

- The Fuego volcano is still active and unpredictable.
- It could continue to spew more rocks, lava, ash, and toxic fumes.
- Huge amounts of ash and debris have been deposited over a wide area so people may still breath it in.
