Course Types

A LEVEL	VOCATIONAL (INCLUDES BTEC, TECHNICAL, LIBF, WJEC)	IB (INTER BACCALAUREATE)
Advanced Level Qualifications (known as A levels) are subject-based qualifications that can lead to university, further study, training or work. You can normally study three or more A levels over two years. They are usually assessed by a series of examinations.	Vocational Qualifications are work related qualifications available in a wide range of career areas. They are designed to enable the learner to acquire knowledge and skills that meet recognised standards necessary to perform a particular job. Work performance is assessed by coursework, practical observation and/or exams.	The International Baccalaureate® (IB) offers a continuum of international education. The programmes encourage both personal and academic achievement, challenging students to excel in their studies and in their personal development. The work is usually assessed by coursework and exams. We have a mix of higher level (equivalent of a full A Level) and standard level qualifications (equivalent of half (AS) an A Level).
You can choose a mix of all 3 qualification types if you would like from our range of options. We would encourage you to link this to a post 18 career goal.		

HOW TO APPLY

How do I apply for the sixth form?

All of our applications are completed online through <https://www.kentprospectus.co.uk/>. If you are a Year 11 student from a Kent school, you should be registered for your account by your school in early November. You should receive a letter from your current provider with your login details.

If you are from a school that is outside Kent or you are in Year 12, looking to change sixth forms, you will need to self-register and create an account in order to apply. This can be done on the same website.

When to apply? What happens after I send my application?

The best time to apply is January-March 2021 of Year 11. We can, of course, deal with enquiries right up to the first week of Year 12 in September, although popular courses may be already over-subscribed, so the earlier you apply, the better for you. If your GCSE results are not as you expected and/or you change your mind about your subject choices, you should still come to see us on results day (or contact us over email) so that we can adjust our offer.

Those students currently at Wrotham; your Year 11 team will distribute the Kent Choice logins between term 2 and 3. They will provide some support sessions with your tutors to also advise you and support you through your application process.

Once your application is in, interviews will take place via telephone with a member of the sixth form team. These interviews are informal, because our aim is to explore whether we can meet your needs and answer any questions both you and your parent/s may have. We will include career guidance during this interview to advise you on the best options to choose from. These usually take place between term 5 and term 6. If you are applying from another school, please have in mind your most recent predicted grades from your subjects.
