- Many strongly believe that the school has improved since the last inspection

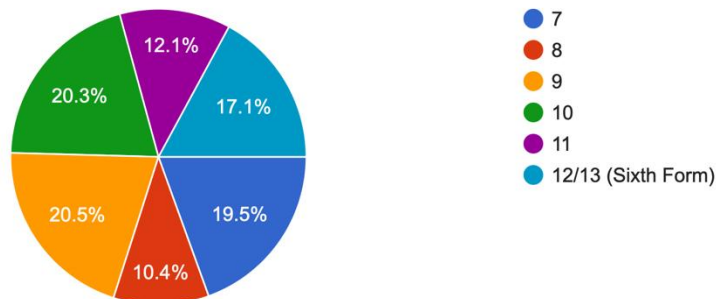
AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT
