## Directed Provision Policy/ Guide

Work for students who are suspended/ or unable to attend school

March 2024

(Non- Statutory Policy - To be reviewed when required)

### Introduction:

At Wrotham School, we are committed to providing continuous education and support to all our students, even in circumstances where they are unable to attend school due to suspension or long-term absence. To ensure that students can continue their learning during these periods, we have established Oak Academy as a directed provision platform.

### Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the procedures and expectations for students to engage with Oak Academy's directed provision program during suspension or long-term absence from Wrotham School. This policy aims to maintain continuity in education, support students' academic progress, and facilitate their successful reintegration into school upon their return.

### Scope:

This policy applies to all students enrolled at Wrotham School who are suspended or on long-term absence and are required to engage with directed provision through Oak Academy.

### Policy:

#### 1. Identification of Oak Academy as Directed Provision:

- Oak Academy is identified as the directed provision platform for students at Wrotham School to complete their educational activities during suspension or long-term absence.

#### 2. Access and Enrollment:

- The school will provide students with access to Oak Academy's online learning platform and assist them in enrolling in relevant courses or subjects aligned with their academic curriculum. (See guide Appendix A)

#### 3. Expectations for Student Engagement:

- Students are expected to engage with directed provision activities on Oak Academy daily, following their regular school timetable, for the duration of their suspension or absence.

- Students must complete assigned lessons, assignments, and assessments within the specified timelines set by their teachers or school administrators.
- Attendance and progress on Oak Academy will be monitored by designated school staff to ensure compliance with directed provision requirements.

#### 4. **Support and Monitoring:**

- Teachers and support staff will provide guidance and assistance to students as they navigate Oak Academy's platform and complete their assigned tasks. (see Appendix A)
- Regular check-ins and communication between students and designated school staff will be established to monitor progress, address any challenges, and provide academic support as needed.

#### 5. **Integration with School Curriculum:**

- Oak Academy's directed provision activities will align with the school's curriculum, ensuring continuity in learning and progression of academic skills and knowledge. - Upon the student's return to school after suspension or long-term absence, teachers will review their progress on Oak Academy and review their completion of directed provision tasks.
- Students may be required to undergo assessments or evaluations to gauge their understanding of the material covered during their time on Oak Academy and to facilitate their transition back into regular classroom instruction.

#### **Review and Revision:**

This Oak Academy Directed Provision Policy will be reviewed annually by the school administration to ensure its effectiveness and relevance. Any necessary revisions or updates will be made in consultation with relevant stakeholders, including staff, students, and parents/guardians.
